

Town and Village of Parish Special Meeting
April 4, 2018
Mills & Petrie Gym

Mayor Perkins called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Mayor Perkins; Trustee Murphy; Trustee Houghton; Trustee Zender; Councilor Dunham; Councilor J. Horning; Councilor G. R. Horning and Evelyn M. Stelmashuck, Village Clerk.

Excused: Supervisor Phillips, Councilor Jordan.

Absent: Trustee Cusson-LaRue

Also Present: Deputy Supervisor Ruczynski; Paul Gage, Planning Board; Karen Gage and Rodney Perkins, residents.

Mayor Perkins said the reason for the Special Meeting was to ask the Town if they wanted to rent more space if the Village vacates the building. Deputy Supervisor Ruczynski said the Town Board will discuss it in more depth. Councilor J. Horning said the Board will meet with Supervisor Phillips the next night and they will discuss it. Councilor Dunham said maybe the Tax Collector and Historian could move to the Clerk's office. Trustee Houghton said at one time the Town was looking for an office for the bookkeeper. Deputy Supervisor Ruczynski said there are 5 or more filing cabinets belonging to the Historian that are blocking the heaters and they need to be moved out. Trustee Zender said information needs to be purged after 3 years. The Town got copies of the Town lease. Trustee Zender said she wants to bring a remodeling contractor in to look at the bank. Deputy Supervisor Ruczynski said he and Trooper Charlie Nellis were the ones investigating the Parish bank robbery back in the 70's. Councilor J. Horning said Parish Key Bank made a mistake on his bank account and he lost \$2,500 that he never got back.

Adjournment: Trustee Houghton made a motion to adjourn at 7:22pm, which was seconded by Trustee Murphy. Roll taken... carried.
