# RABIES CLINICS



*Suggested donation \$7.00 per pet*

- *All Rabies Clinics are by appointment ONLY on Wednesday evenings from 6 to 8pm*
- *If you are unable to keep your appointment, please call to cancel it.*
- *COVID preventative measures may be required based on current pandemic status.*
- *If you or your pets are sick, please reschedule your appointment.*
- All pets must be at least 3 months of age. Pets receiving their first rabies shot must get a booster within 1 year.
- All pets must be restrained on a leash or in a pet carrier.
- Proof of previous vaccination is required to qualify for a three-year certificate. Accepted forms of proof:
  - “Certificate of Vaccination” obtained from veterinarian or Oswego County Environmental Division or
  - “Dog license” showing rabies expiration date.
