Wednesday March 21, 2018

Mayor Perkins called the Public Hearing to order at 6:45 pm followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll Call: Present – Mayor Perkins, Trustee Houghton, Trustee Murphy and Evelyn M. Stelmashuck, Village Clerk.

Absent: Trustee Cusson-LaRue, Trustee Zender and Attorney Ventre.

Purpose: Mayor Perkins said the purpose of the Public Hearing is to propose a Local Law amending the residency requirement for the Village Clerk.

Public Comments: None.

Trustee Murphy made a motion stating: No person appointed to the office of Village Clerk or Deputy Village Clerk or who is performing the duties of either, shall be required to be a resident of the Village of Parish the time of appointment or throughout the term of office provided that such person is, at the time of appointment and throughout the term of office, a resident of the Town of Parish. And...Supersession of State Law: This law is intended to supersede, in part, those provisions of Village Law 3-300 and Subdivision 1 of 223 of the Public Officers Law which require a Village Clerk or a person who is performing the duties of any such officer to be a resident of the Village of Parish, which was seconded by Trustee Houghton, all in favor, motion carried.

Adjournment:

Trustee Houghton motioned to adjourn at 6:47 pm which was seconded by Trustee Murphy, all in favor, motion carried.
