Regular Monthly Board Meeting
Parish Village Gym, Wednesday, October 16, 2024

Call To Order: Mayor Murphy called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm followed by the pledge.

Roll call: Mayor Murphy, Trustee Allardice, Trustee Brown, Trustee Lapira. Trustee Youngman had an excused absence.

Approval Of Minutes: Trustee Brown made a motion, which was seconded by Trustee Allardice to accept the minutes from the Board meeting September 18, 2024 and Joint Town/Village Board Meeting 9/12/24. Roll Taken, All in Favor...Carried.

Communications: Mary Chappell and c2ae reports the Bids for project pending approval.

Reports:

Sewer Plant Report: Facility checks and services were conducted as scheduled. Flows entering facility averaged 37,000 gallons per day. Peak daily flow for the period was 236,000 gallons/day. There was a couple of call backs on North Railroad lift station this month. Eggans pumped out both digesters and influent channel for a total of 30,000 gallons. Significant DEC non compliant as per SPDES permit. Current and future projects are the plant upgrade. Trustee Brown made a motion to accept the sewer plant report, which was seconded by Trustee Lapira. Roll Taken, All In Favor...Carried.

Building Inspector/Code Enforcement Officer-Will

Hamacher: During the month of September he has been busy with several building inspections, addressing some property maintenance violations, doing property re-inspections, returning phone calls, working with property owners regarding violations, addressing emails, researching FOIL requests, contacting the DEC regarding wetlands, spoke with the County Health Department and Real Property. He has also been in contact with the Planning Board Chair and the Zoning Board regarding several properties. He has done some plan reviews for 2 new houses and a charging station for Mirabito gas station. He has spoken with his Deputy and come up with a start

date to do fire inspections and also in the process of closing out some building projects. He has completed pro housing survey paperwork for the village. He has been working with his code software provider with some permitting issues. Trustee brown made a motion to accept the Code Enforcer Report, which was seconded by Trustee Lapira. Roll Taken, All In Favor...Carried.

Tug Hill: Paul Baxter gave report on Tug Hill. Minutes for the Salmon Rivers Council of Governments meeting of Tuesday, August 27 are now available and have been posted to the Salmon Rivers website (salmonrivers.org). There is nothing new to report about the wildlife management area payment legislation or the salmon restoration to the Little Salmon River. Trustee Brown made a motion to accept the Tug Hill report, which was seconded by Trustee Allardice. Roll Taken, All In Favor...Carried.

Presentation/Discussion: Kevin Dwyer is looking into a different option for paying sewer bills.

Grievances/Concerns: None.

Old Business:

Airbnb sewer discussion: Letter will be sent to owners telling them about the increased sewer units and the reason for the increase.

Entryway Bids: The Village has several bids for the entryway. Will will be getting 1 more bid from Lowes and review them at next Board Meeting.

Sign in Canfield Park: Trustee Allardice is working on the sign for Canfield Park.

New Business:

Appointees: Kevin Dwyer was appointed as Village Treasurer and Rosemary Eldred was appointed as Village Clerk. Oath cards will be signed. Trustee Brown made a motion to accept above appointees, which was seconded by Trustee Lapira . Roll Taken, All In Favor...Carried.
